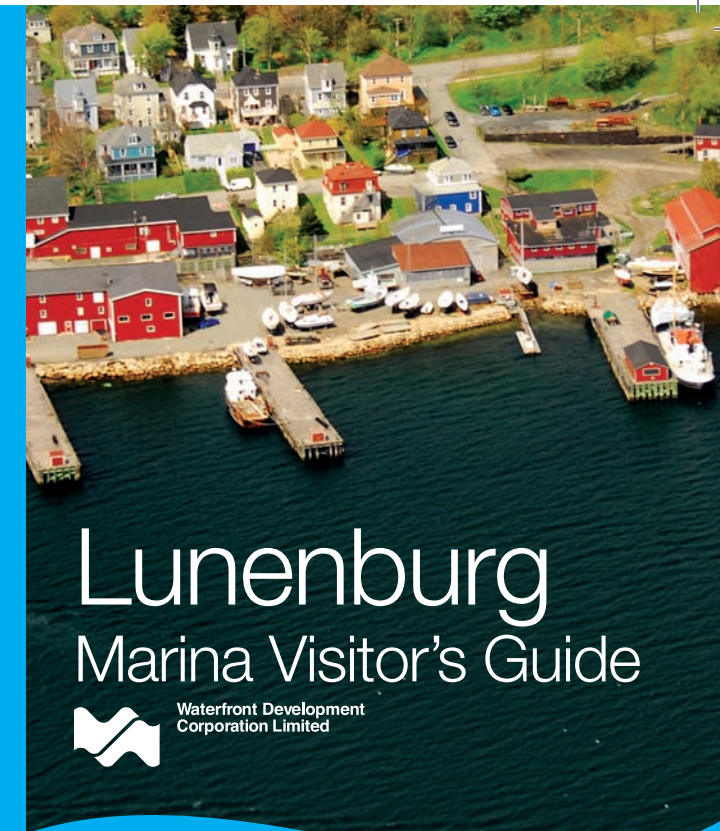
Tour, Explore and Enjoy Culinary Delights

Marina Services

Welcome to Lunenburg's Historic Working Waterfront. Our picturesque waterfront is home to tall ships, schooners, dories, fishing vessels and floating docks. Our docks provide free daily berthing as available. We also offer overnight and long-term berthing options. We hope you enjoy this port of call.

Quick Guide

① Fisheries Museum

Free public berthing for up to an hour. Hourly and overnight rates are available by contacting Museum staff at:

Water is available at no charge; please inquire for garbage disposal.

Please Note: *No Smoking is allowed on the wharves or Museum property. It is very important that boaters understand that the wooden wharves represent a fire hazard.*

The Visitor's Dock

The Visitor's Dock is a receiving area for visiting boats.

Public Docking for Tenders/Dinghies

Public access to and from the waterfront.

- Dinghies and tenders are permitted to dock for free.
- Overnight berthing may be available. Please contact the Waterfront Attendant for availability and fees.
- Loading and unloading of boats up to 40' is permitted when space is available.
- Garbage receptacles are available; sorted garbage only.

③ Marina Wharf

③ Marina Wharf Marina Services for Visiting Boaters (provided by Echo Bay Marine)

Repairs can be completed and specialty services can be arranged upon request.

- Berthage for boats up to 45' is available at the floats; larger vessels can berth at the wharves.
- For berth and mooring reservations contact the Yacht Shop, adjacent to the Marina. Fees will apply.
- Power, water, sewage pump out are available.
- Haul out is available.
- For up to 20 gallons of fuel, transport to a gas station and jerry jugs can be provided. 100 gallons or more can be arranged with truck delivery.
- Garbage receptacles are available; sorted garbage only.
